

### Day One, Sunday May 11th

#### Arrival, Orientation tour

Early morning flight with Aer Lingus from Dublin to Toulouse. Coach transfer to four-star hotel in Lourdes, where we will stay four nights on a full-board basis. Check-in and some free time for rest. Later, we will gather at the hotel and walk down to the Sanctuary for an orientation tour. We will visit the Grotto, where Our Lady appeared to Bernadette multiple times in 1858 and announced that she was the Immaculate Conception. We will also visit the Basilica of the Rosary and the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception built over the Grotto. Mass celebration. Dinner and overnight.

#### Day Two, Monday May 12th

## Mass, Walking tour of Lourdes

After breakfast, Mass celebration in the sanctuary. Free time to visit the Grotto and for personal prayer. Lunch in the hotel. In the mid-afternoon, we will have a walking tour of town, including the cemetery where the Soubirous family is buried, the Boly Mill (birthplace of St. Bernadette whose father was a miller) and the *Cachot*, an abandoned prison where the family was living at the time of the apparitions. Dinner at the hotel. After dinner, we will walk down to the Sanctuary to participate in the candlelight procession (begins at 9pm every evening).

#### Day Three, Tuesday May 13<sup>th</sup>

#### Baths, Stations of the Cross, Free time

After breakfast, celebration of Mass in a chapel in the sanctuary. This morning will be dedicated to visiting the baths, an important part of any pilgrimage to Lourdes. Some queuing is usually necessary. The water in the baths flows from the spring that was unearthed by Bernadette at Our Lady's command. Countless healings, both physical and spiritual, have occurred here. Lunch in the hotel. There will be Stations of the Cross in the prairie across the river after lunch. Rest of the afternoon free. At 5pm every day there is a Eucharistic procession which finishes with Benediction in the underground basilica. Dinner. Candlelight procession at 9pm.

#### Day Four, Wednesday May 14th

Bartres

After breakfast, coach excursion to Bartres, the little village outside Lourdes where Bernadette spent some of her childhood. Mass in the parish church of St John the Baptist and blessing with a first-class relic of St Bernadette. Return to hotel for lunch. Free afternoon. Dinner at the hotel. Candlelight procession at 9pm.

Breakfast and check out. Departure for airport (exact airport to be confirmed when Aer Lingus confirms their schedules). Check in for our direct flight to Dublin.
